Steps to Browse & Request as a Learner

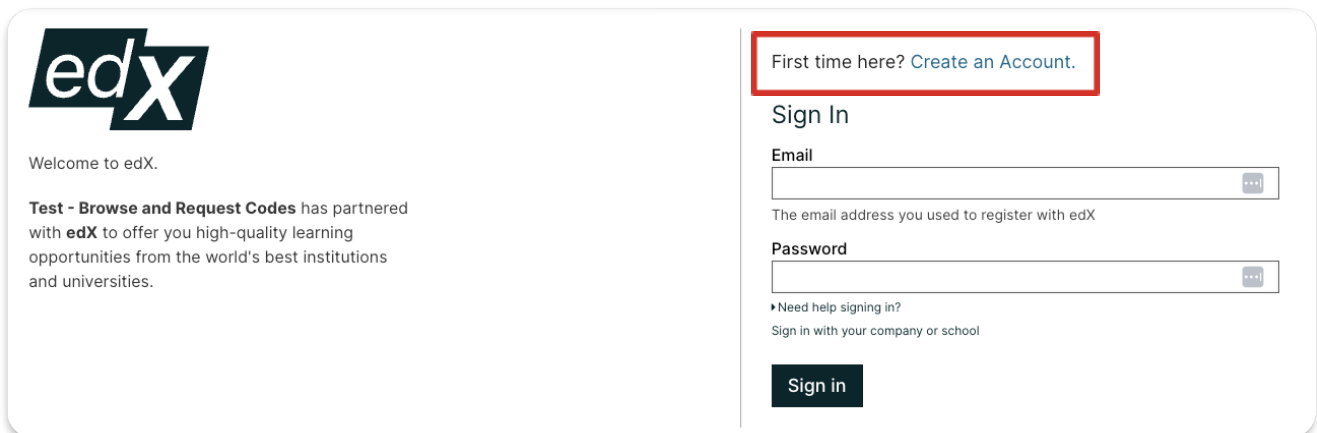
- Step 1: Create account and sign in via the link provided by your Admin

Browse & Request Steps

Below are the steps required to successfully browse and request content from the learner dashboard.

Step 1: Create account or sign in via the link provided by your Admin

Create an account or login to your existing edX account using the unique link provided to you by your organization (contact the admin at your organization if you don't have access - They will provide you with the appropriate link)

Once you have requested an enrollment the "Request enrollment" button will refresh and show "Awaiting approval":

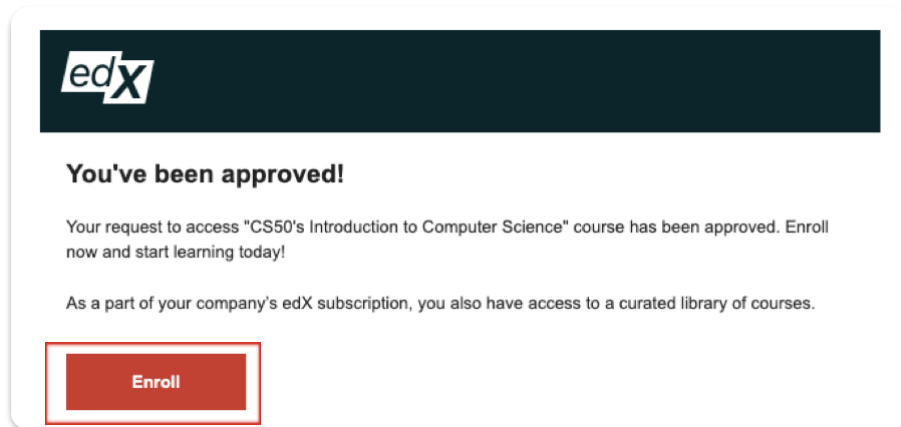


Your learner dashboard will also reflect the requested course under "My courses":

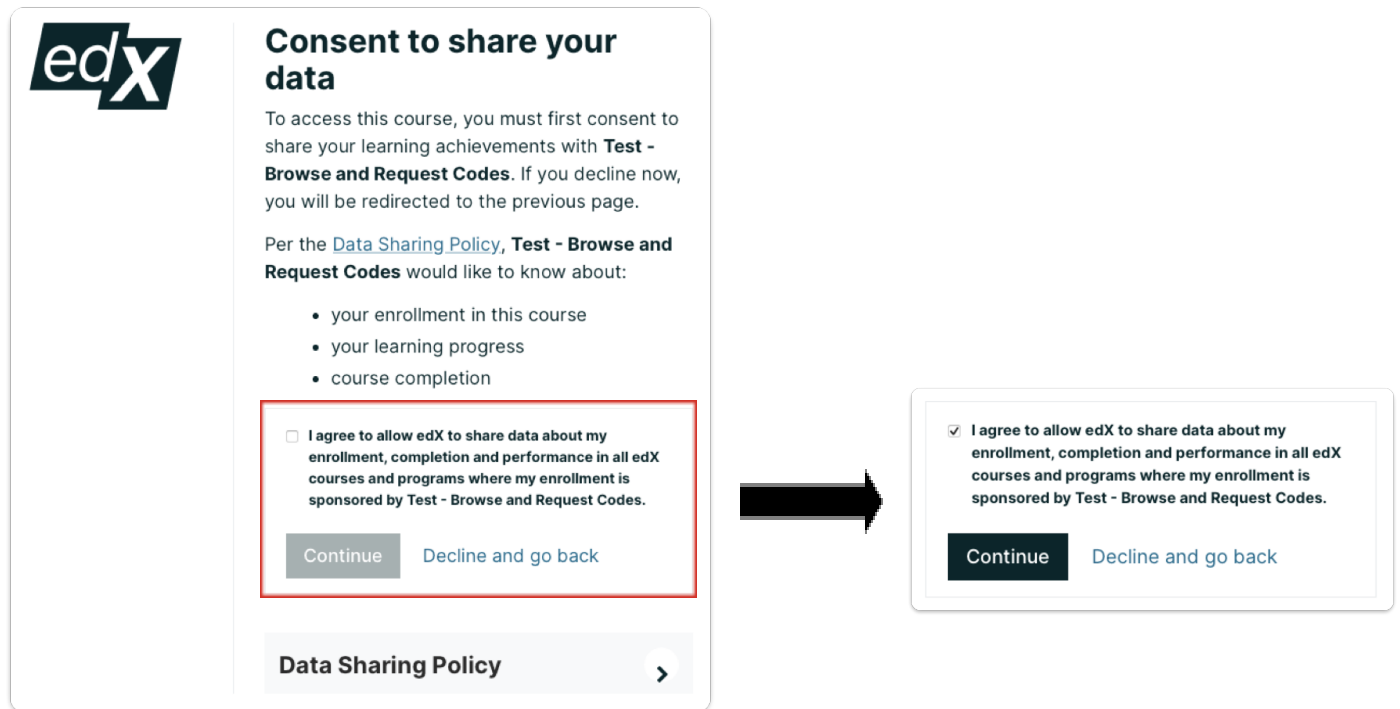

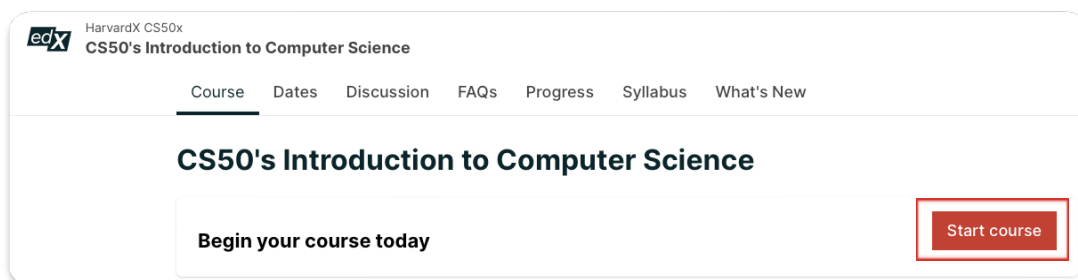
